NCK Tech Certified Nurse Aide Courses 2020-2021

The CNA course is designed to train health care assistants in the basic skills necessary to assist nurses in a variety of health care settings and to be efficient health care team members. Upon completion of the course, students will be eligible to take the state CNA Examination.

All courses are approved by the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services (KDADS).

CNA ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS (all CNA classes):

1. Student must be at least **16 years of age** by the course end date.
2. **TB skin test** is required, provide documentation BEFORE first day of class.
3. Seasonal **Flu shot** is required for clinicals held during months of October-April, provide documentation BEFORE first day of class.
4. **Attendance is required in ALL class and clinical sessions – check clinical location and schedule before enrolling (see opposite page).** *If you have other commitments (sports, clubs, a job, etc.) that will interfere with this schedule, you are advised to take this course at a more convenient time.*
5. Students must earn **80% or better in course work** to be eligible for the state certification test.
6. Purchase Textbook – Hartman’s Nursing Assistant Care: the Basics, 5th Ed. (ISBN 978-1-60425-100-5) – available online.
7. **Scrubs** to wear to clinical.
8. **Physical requirements:** Students must be physically able to perform all skills satisfactorily, which includes ability to lift 50+ pounds.
