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

#### CERTIFIED NURSE AIDE COURSE-SPRING 2024 COURSE REQUIREMENTS

The CNA course is designed to train health care assistants in the basic skills necessary to assist nurses in a variety of health care settings and to be efficient health care team members. Upon completion of the course, students will be eligible to take the state CNA Examination. All courses are approved by the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services (KDADS).

- The following documentation is needed after enrolling in the course:
  - 16 years of age by the course end date
  - TB Skin test (test must be within the last year)
  - Documentation of the following vaccinations, or notify instructor of need for vaccination exemption from the clinical facility:
    - COVID-19
    - Flu shot (for clinicals held during fall/winter months)
- This is a hands-on course/career. Students MUST be physically able to perform all skills satisfactorily, which includes ability to lift 50+ pounds.
- Criminal convictions may jeopardize eligibility for certification and/or employment. If you are unsure or have questions about this, please contact the Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services/Health Occupations Credentialing (KDADS/HOC): kimberly.garrett@ks.gov or 785.296.6958.
- Attendance is required in ALL class and clinical sessions. Check the clinical location and schedule before registering in the class to make sure it fits your schedule. If you have other commitments (sports, clubs, a job, etc) that will interfere with this schedule, you are advised to take this course at a more convenient time.
- Uniform: Scrubs (any color/pattern) and a watch with a second hand for clinicals.
- Textbook: Kansas CNA Curriculum Guidelines. This book is provided to the student in pdf format and is included in the course tuition/.fees.
- Class size is limited to 10 students
  - Students will only have a seat in the class after they make full payment
  - Students can NOT drop or withdraw the course after it begins.
  - No refunds are issued once payment is made.
